- Support for Mothers & Babies Act (Passage HB 2002) - Provided \$1 M to which PRCs could apply for grants - 3/8/23
- Women's Right to Know (Passage SB 552) (sought to reinstate laws that were voided when HB302 passed); Sen version good, Hse version gutted of everything except language protecting HB302 - 3/1/23
- HB 302 - Unborn Child Protection Act (banned abortion from implantation, L/R8/I14 exceptions, only licensure penalties for MDs) - 9/13/22
- Unborn Child with Down Syndrome Protection and Education Act - Passage (SB 468) - 3/2/22
- Second Chances at Life Act of 2021 – Passage (HB 2982) – 4/10/21
- Born-Alive Abortion Survivors Protection Act - vote to concur and pass HB 4007 - 2/19/2020
- SJR 12 No Constitutional Right to Abortion Amendment - Passage (SJR 12) - 2/9/2018
- Parent's Right to Know Act - Passage (HB 2002) - 4/8/2017
- Parent's Right to Know Act - 3rd Reading - Amendment to amend HB 2002 - 4/8/2017
- Senate Override of Gov Tomblin's veto of Unborn Child Protection from Dismemberment Abortion Act (UCPDA), SB 10 - 3/10/2016
- Passage of UCPDA (SB 10) - 2/17/2016
- Senate Override of Gov Tomblin's veto of HB 2568, the Pain-Capable Unborn Child Protection Act (PCUCPA) - 3/6/2015
- Passage of the PCUCPA (HB 2568) - 2/25/2015
- Palumbo amendment to change fetal age from 20 wks to 24 in Pain-Capable Act (HB 2568) successfully rejected - 2/25/2015
